The Papers of Julius C. Holmes, Deputy, G-5 Division, SHAEF, 1944, and Assistant Secretary of State, 1944-45, were deposited in the Dwight D. Eisenhower Library by his son, Henry Allen Holmes, in June 1970. A small accretion was received from the National Archives in May 1993.

An instrument of gift for these papers was signed by Henry Allen Holmes in May 1976. Literary property rights are retained by the donor until his death. At that time such rights pass to the United States. Under terms of the instrument of gift the following classes of documents are withheld from research use:

1. Papers relating to the family and private business affairs.
2. Papers relating to the family and private business affairs of persons who have had correspondence with General Holmes.
3. Papers relating to investigations of individuals or to appointments and personnel matters.
4. Papers containing statements made by or to General Holmes in confidence unless in the judgement of the Director of the Dwight D. Eisenhower Library the reason for the confidentiality no longer exists.
5. All other papers which contain information or statements that might be used to injure, harass, or damage any living person.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The personal papers of Julius C. Holmes cover the period from 1936 to 1948 with a few items dated from 1968. The bulk of the collection consists of General Holmes' "201 File" (1936-1948). Also included is correspondence (primarily personal), awards and commissions, a biographical sketch, and a reprint of an address delivered by General Holmes in 1945. Included among the correspondents are Mark Clark, General H. Giraud, General Frank McSherry, Frederick E. Morgan, Edward R. Stettinius, and Walter Bedell Smith.

The collection is arranged alphabetically by type of material and chronologically thereunder. Four photographs were transferred to the Eisenhower Library Audiovisual Collection.
