DESCRIPTION: Interview #1. Eisenhower's speech in 1946 to either the American Society for Public Administration or the Civil Service Assembly, first time to meet Eisenhower; White House reception for Supreme Court, 1953; National Bureau of Standards: co-workers, battery additives, Allen Astin, Sinclair Weeks; International Geophysical Year; DDE's abilities as an administrator; Harwood's understanding of the scientific community; Vannevar Bush; Oppenheimer investigation; McCarthyism; National Science Foundation; 1968 Presidential election; DDE's trip to Iran in 1959 or 1960.
