

## EWALD RESEARCH FILES

### SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The series of the Fred Seaton papers which arrived at the Library labeled "Ewald Research Files" consists of thirty-five archives boxes of press releases, printed matter, newspaper clippings, reports, and so forth, presumably collected by William B. Ewald, Jr., Assistant to the Secretary of the Interior, and filed according to subject. There is little, if any, correspondence in this file. The collection was evidently maintained as background information by Ewald, who worked with Seaton on approximately 130 speeches between 1956 and the end of the Administration. The subjects are numerous, including Interior Department topics, party politics, and government operations in general. The folders are in alphabetical order.
