

Letter, Dwight D. Eisenhower to Everett. E. "Swede" Hazlett
October 11, 1941

"Both last summer and this I made very short visits to Abilene. My Father and Mother are both still living there, although both are getting feeble. During each visit, I have had a chance to call on most of our old friends, notably Mr. Harger, Charlie Case, Art Hart, Reynold Rogers, the Sterl brothers and Henry Giles. I mustn't forget Joner Calahan. All of them seem to be going their accustomed ways with very little noticeable change either in themselves or in the town."
